

**Seminole County COVID-19 Return to Play Operating Expectations for Rentals**

*Seminole County has set forth the following expectations for the individual renter/organization hosting practice and game rentals at our facilities. Please review carefully as these expectations must be instituted and managed by the individual renter/organization to ensure that rentals operate safely for all parties. It is the responsibility of the individual renter/organization to ensure that these expectations below are communicated to all teams, players, coaches, officials, parents and spectators prior to each rental. Furthermore it is the sole responsibility of the individual renter/organization to ensure that these expectations are adhered to throughout each rental.*

**Seminole County Expectations for Individual Renters/Organizations**

- All individual renters/organizations are encouraged to practice social distancing and maintain at a minimum of 6 feet apart from one another. Individual renter/organization is responsible to ensure appropriate social distancing throughout their rental space (field/court/pavilion/etc.) as well as player seating areas, spectator seating areas, and all other spaces utilized when visiting the park.
- Discourage team meetings or huddles on field and use alternatives to handshakes (verbal phrase and body language)
- Individual renter/organization is responsible for the removal of any player, staff, coach, umpire or spectator who appears or is showing signs of COVID-19.
- All individual renter/organization players, staff, coaches, spectators, and officials are strongly encouraged to wear a cloth face covering while at the facility when social distancing cannot be observed.
- All teams, spectators, coaches, and officials should bring their own hand sanitizer to the facility as access to hand sanitizer will be limited.
- We strongly encourage spectators to only remain present at rentals if they are immediate family members. Spectators are encouraged to bring their own chairs to help facilitate social distancing measures.
- No team or personal coolers or outside food is permitted; players should bring their own water or sports drinks to ensure proper hydration. Players should label bottles and fit inside their personal bags. Absolutely no seeds, chewing gum or spitting is allowed anywhere at the venue.
- No sharing of equipment between players- gloves, helmets, catchers gear, bats, racquets, etc.
- During rain delays everyone should return to their vehicle or shelters. Offices and administrative buildings will be closed due to occupancy requirements

**Seminole County will provide the following:**

- Signage and floor markings will be in place throughout the facility reminding all guest of appropriate social distancing protocols.
- Doors will be propped open whenever possible to reduce excessive contact on shared surfaces.
- Tables around concession areas or open spaces will be arranged to provide appropriate social distance between groups. Park staff will rearrange tables throughout the day to continue to provide social distancing.
- Portable hand washing station(s) will be available at the facility providing easier access for guests to wash hands.
- Handwashing soap in the restrooms and limited quantities of liquid hand sanitizer will be available for our guests.
- Concessions staff and park staff will utilize proper protective equipment such as protective Plexiglas barriers and wearing face coverings.
- Public service announcements will be broadcasted over the public address systems throughout the day reminding all to practice social distancing and to proper handwashing.
